The Role

We are seeking enthusiastic, energetic and passionate cricket coaches to work independently to deliver regular weekly sessions, holiday camps, birthday parties, cricket club, school (curriculum & after school) and day nursery Little Wickets' activities/sessions.

Responsibilities

Planning, preparing and delivering sessions for 2 ½ - 7 year old children (separated into 1st Innings sessions for 2 ½ -5 year olds and 2nd Innings sessions for 5-7 year olds) focusing on fundamental movement skills with a cricket theme. In 1st & 2nd Innings sessions a Lead Coach may work independently or with an assistant. Holiday Camp work is also available running cricket-based activities, for Primary School-aged children, as part of a team.

Expectation

Although full training and guidance will be given, we expect Little Wickets Lead Coaches to be self-starters with the capability to work with very young children in a fun and progressive way.

Locations

Currently throughout Nottinghamshire, with new locations being added regularly in Derbyshire & Leicestershire.

Requirements

- Min Level 2 Cricket or Multi-Skills Qualification or equivalent (including evidence that a 'Safeguarding Children' Module has been completed).
- Enhanced DBS check will be required prior to commencing
- Current First Aid Certificate
- Coach's Insurance
- Own Transport
- Preferably Full Membership of the ECB Coaches Association (includes Coach's Insurance)

Hours & Pay

- You will be working on a Self-employed (sub-contractor) basis with hourly rates paid for casual and regular work.
- Rates from £17 to £30 per hour dependent on experience.
- Hours agreed to suit applicant up to 7 days a week including daytime weekday sessions, early evenings & weekends.
- Hours available year-round, during term time & school holidays.
